Sir,

Please refer to your letter No. HIVS/D-83/Incl. of father name in birth certificate /7574-75/2018 dated 03/07/2018 vide which clarification regarding inclusion of name of father in birth certificate of child has been sought.

2. In this connection, it is to clarify that the birth certificate reflects the entry at the time of birth only. However, there is provision under section 15 of the Registration of Births and Deaths (RBD) Act, 1969 and corresponding Rule 11 of Maharashtra Registration of births and deaths, rules 2000, Registrar of births and deaths is competent and allow to take suitable and appropriate action regarding correction/cancellation in birth/death records. It is also to inform that as per the legal provisions of RBD Act, 1969 the matter is within the domain of the State Government which is competent to take action and issue instructions in the matter in consultation with the Advocate General of the State, if required. As such you are required to take necessary action as deemed appropriate at your end.
