Sub: Extension of period for entering the name in Birth Record - amendment
in Rule 10 (1).

Sir,

You are aware that State Rule 10 framed under Section 14 of the Registration of Births and Deaths (RBD) Act, 1969 prescribed specific period of 15 years for entering the name in birth record in respect of those cases where the birth of any child had been registered without a name.

2. In this connection, it is to mention that at the time of introduction of Revamped System of registration of births and deaths, a provision of 15 years period for inclusion of name in birth record was also given for those persons who were born before the commencement of rules framed under the revamped system, in such cases, 15 years period is reckoned from 01-01-2000 i.e. from the date of introduction of revamped system in the State. Due to this provision, public is still availing the facility for entering the name in old birth records i.e. for all those who were born before 01-01-2000. As per the existing provision, the aforesaid 15 years period is going to expire on 31-12-2014. You are also aware that after the expiry of this period, there would be no provision to enter the name in birth record for all old cases, born before the commencement of the existing rules framed under the revamped system.

3. In this connection, this office has received communication from some of the States about the problems faced by the public in entering the name in birth record after the expiry of 15 years period on 31-12-2014 in respect of persons born before 2000. In view of the above facts, they have requested for extension in 15 years period by few more years. In this connection, it is also to mention that even in respect of few States, where 15 years period was not reckoned from the date of notification of revamped rules, they had approached ORGI in the recent past for such relaxation and these States were given special relaxation of 1-2 years for entering the name in birth records.
4. In view of the problems raised by the States in entering the name in birth record after the expiry of such period on 31-12-2014, it has been decided to give further relaxation of five years for such old cases where the name has not been entered in the birth record. In this connection, a draft amendment proposal in respect of necessary amendment in Rule 10 (1) has been framed under Section 14 of the RBD Act, 1969 under which five years relaxation from the date of commencement of new rule has been suggested for those persons, born before the commencement of the proposed new rules. A copy of draft notification is attached as an annexure with the letter. You are hereby granted permission under Section 30 (1) of the RBD Act, 1969 to amend the respective Rule 10 (1) and issue the requisite Notification. Necessary directions on this issue may also be issued to the concerned registration authorities.
5. This office may be apprised about the efforts made in the matter alongwith the copy of notification and direction issued in this regard.

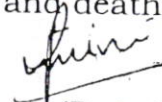

NOTIFICATION

REGISTRATION OF BIRTH AND DEATH ACT, 1969.

No. Jamruno. 2008/75/C.R. 24/F.W. 2.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 30 read with section 14 of the Registration of Birth and Death Act, 1969 (18 of 1969), the Government of Maharashtra with the approval of Central Government, hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Maharashtra Registration of Births and Deaths Rules, 2000, namely :—

1. These rules may be called the Maharashtra Registration of Births and Deaths, (2nd Amendment) Rules, 2015.

2. In rule 10 of the Maharashtra Registration of Births and Deaths Rules, 2000 in sub-rule (1), in the proviso, for the portion beginning with the words “ which shall be reckoned ” and ending with the words “ the Registrar shall,-” the following shall be substituted, as follows, name :—

“ which shall be reckoned,—

(I) in case where the registration has been made prior to the date of commencement of the Registration of Births and Deaths Rules, 2000, further five years period shall be given, in respect of those cases, where fifteen years period has been completed at the time of publication of the Maharashtra Registration of Births and Deaths (2nd Amendment) Rules, 2015, or

(II) in case where the registration is made after the date of commencement of the Maharashtra Registration of Births and Deaths (2nd Amendment) Rules, 2015, from the date of such registration, subject to the provisions of sub-section (4) of section 23, and the Registrar shall,”.
